
<u>Project Overview</u>: The funds paid design and architectural planning costs for a new, residential facility to address the behavioral health needs of female youth ages 13 to 18. The approximately 30,000-square-foot facility on State-owned property in Exeter will include two, eight-bedroom suites, activity rooms, classrooms, a media center, visitor space, and staff offices. Recreational spaces will include a fitness center, gym, multi-use outdoor courts, and a sports field. Construction is scheduled for completion by late spring 2026.


