Project Overview: This program created a fund that will preserve affordable housing through foreclosure prevention or rehabilitation. The Rhode Island Department of Housing granted an award to the Community Housing Land Trust of Rhode Island (CHLT) to establish the fund. CHLT “is a non-profit affiliated with the Housing Network of Rhode Island with a mission to expand and maintain the supply of long-term affordable housing available for generations of Rhode Islanders.”¹

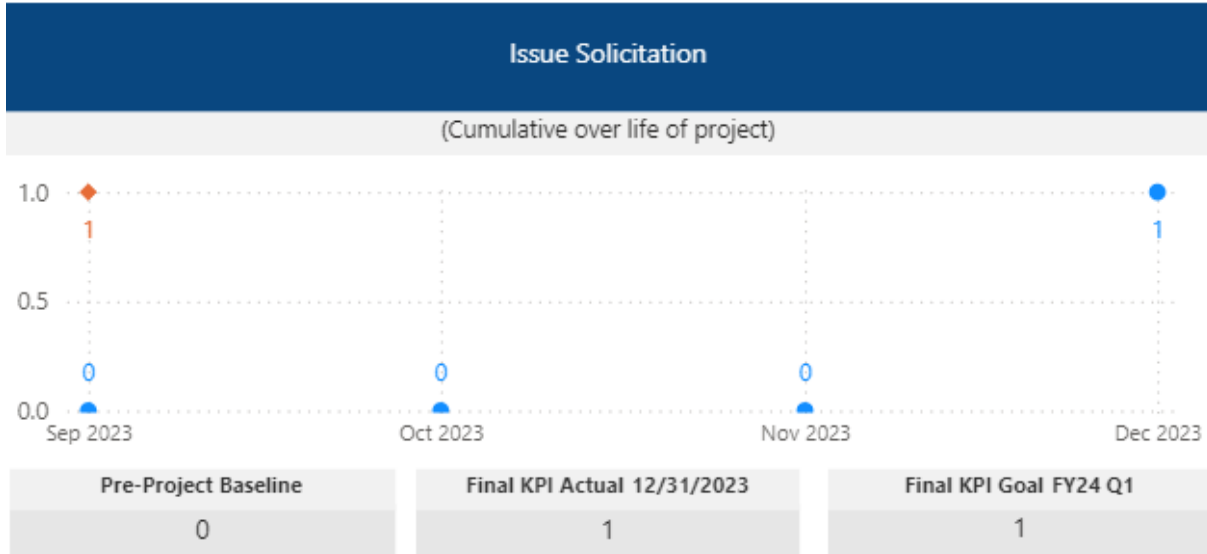

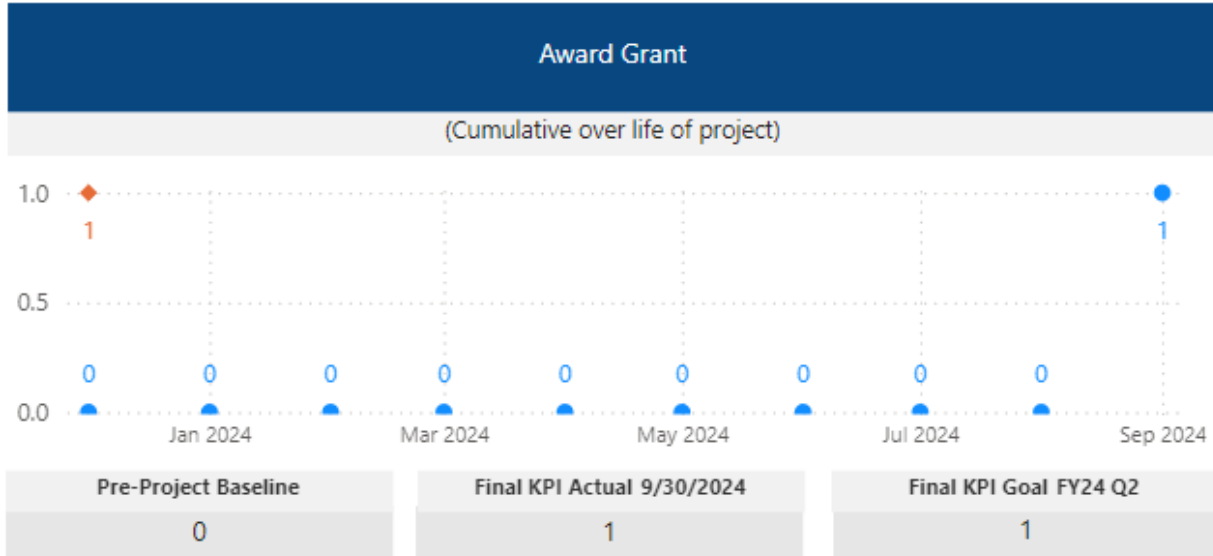
