Problem Statement: Homelessness in Rhode Island increased significantly during the pandemic. Between 2021 and 2023, the Rhode Island Point in Time Counts found that the number of people experiencing homelessness increased by 43%, the number of people in emergency shelters increased by 48%, and the number of people living outdoors increased by 85%.<sup>1</sup>

Project Overview: The State used approximately \$2.6 million of the funding to finance capital improvements at two facilities in Providence – the State-owned Cranston Street Armory to serve as a 24-hour/7-day a week (24/7) warming center and the Crossroads Rhode Island-operated facility at 662 Hartford Ave. to serve as a shelter for homeless couples.

The State paid Amos House \$1.6 million to operate the Cranston Street Armory warming center to meet individuals' basic needs and provide other supports, including transportation, housing assistance, medication, and emergency expenses. The State paid Crossroads Rhode Island \$0.7 million to operate the shelter for homeless couples at 662 Hartford Ave.

The State paid the remaining \$2.1 million to service providers to operate shelters and expand shelter capacity at other locations across the state. They included:

- **Catholic Social Services:** Increased shelter capacity at Emmanuel House in Providence.
- **Community Care Alliance:** Provided shelter capacity and supportive services in Woonsocket and North Smithfield.
- **Elizabeth Buffum Chace Center:** Provided wraparound case management services to help individuals experiencing homelessness find transitional or permanent housing.
- **Newport Community Mental Health Center Inc.:** Operated a temporary warming center at 50 Washington Square in Newport.
- **Open Doors:** Operated a 24/7 warming center at 1139 Main St. in Pawtucket and rooms at Motel 6 in Warwick as an emergency shelter.
- **Rhode Island Coalition for the Homeless Inc.:** Served patients of Thundermist Health Center, Providence Community Health Centers and Brown University Health who were experiencing homelessness and had acute medical and behavioral health conditions.
- **Thrive Behavioral Health:** Rented hotel rooms to provide shelter.
- **Westerly Area Rest Meals Inc.:** Rented hotel rooms in Westerly to provide shelter.

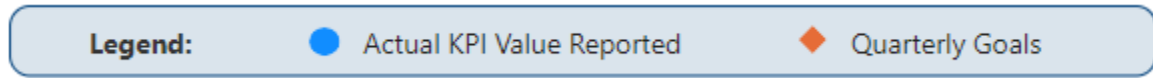

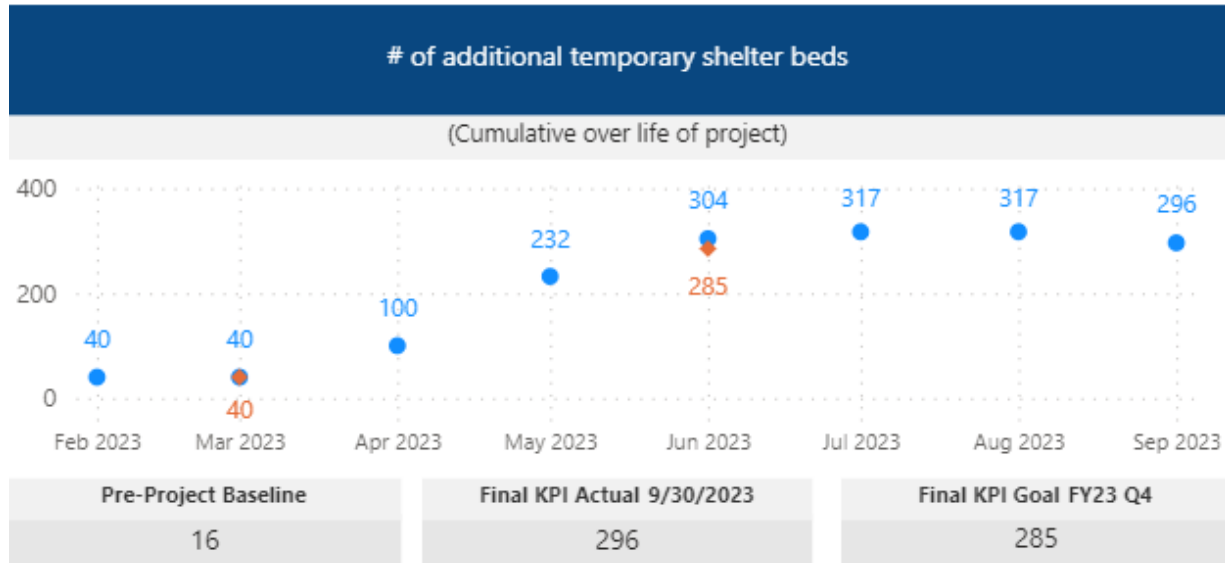

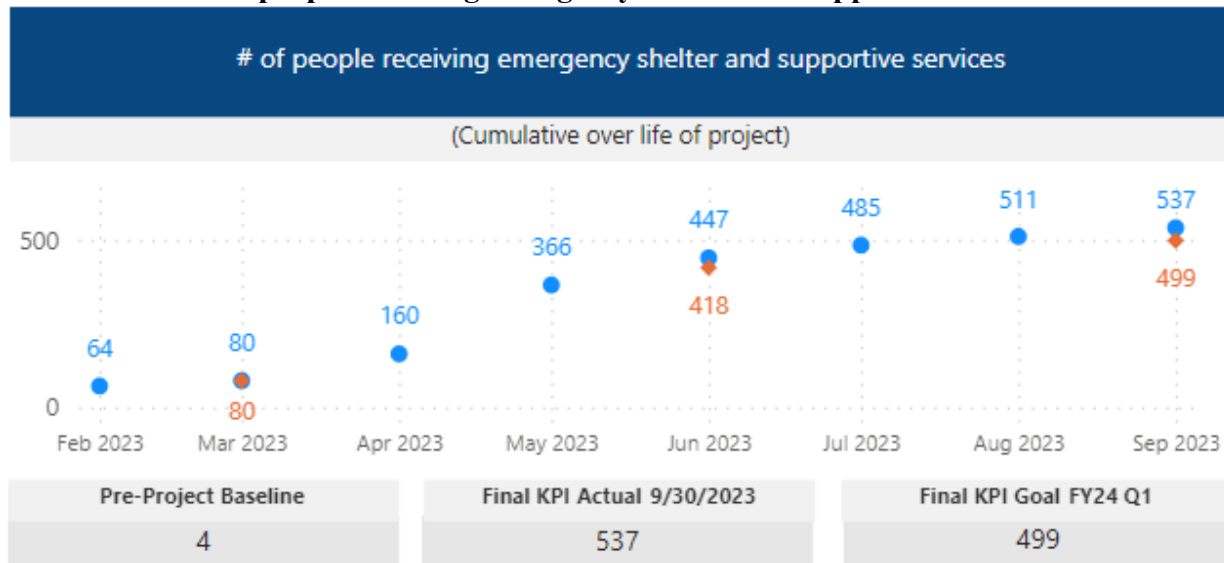

### 1. Number of additional temporary shelter beds

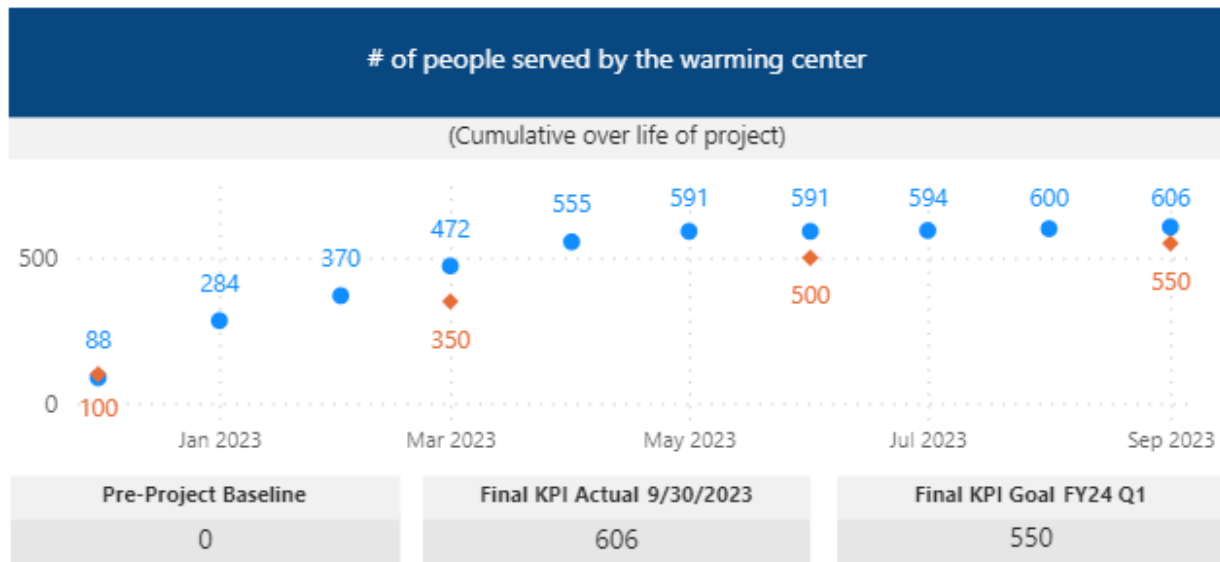


### 2. Number of people receiving emergency shelter and supportive services



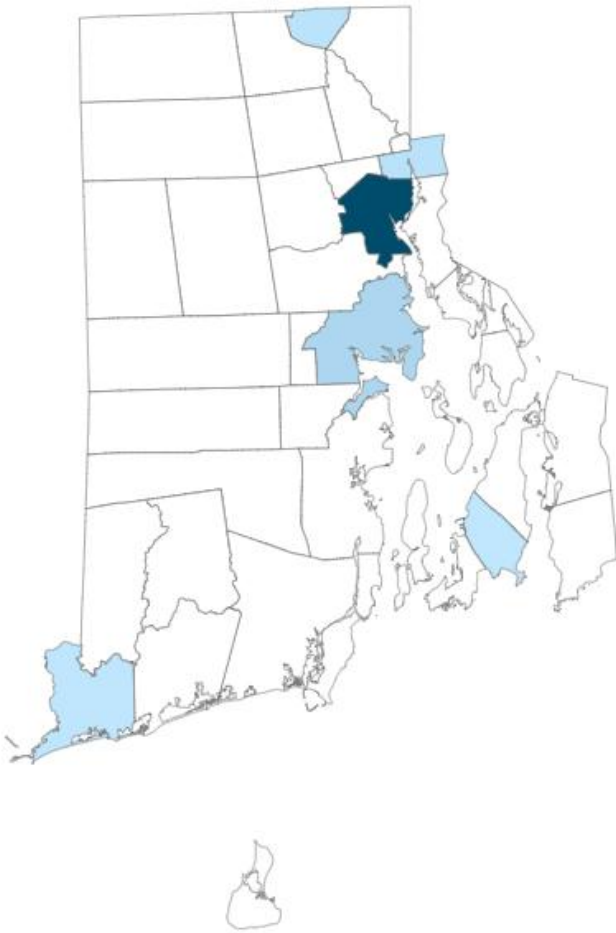


### 3. Number of people served by the warming center

**Distribution of Homelessness Assistance: Warming Center and Shelter Funding by Municipality - Total**



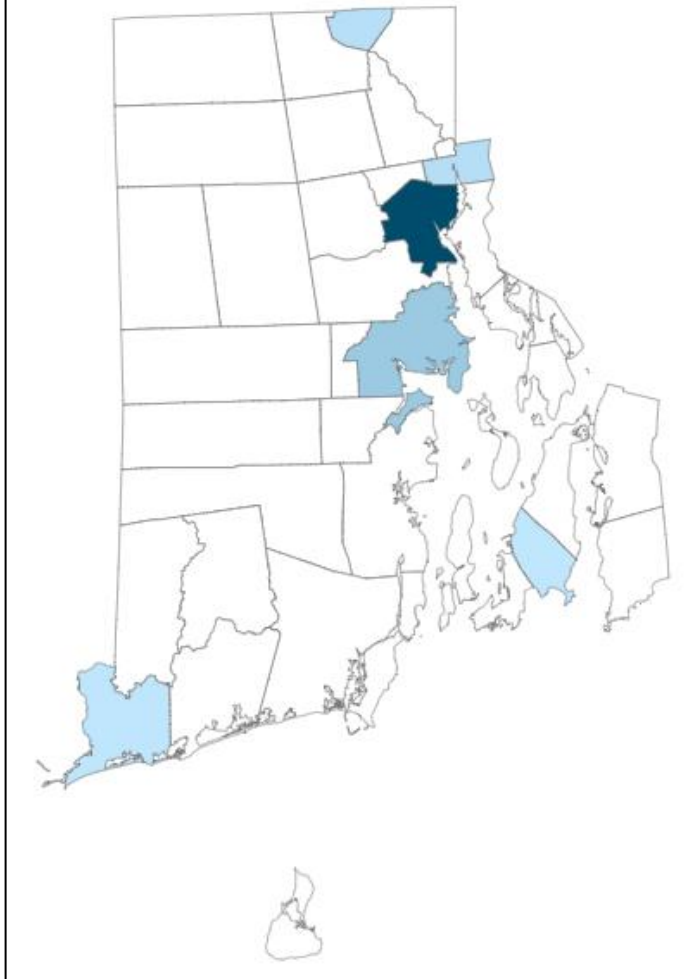
